regions. His photography skills were cuite outstanding as was his identification of each slide with the common name and scientific name. He gave a glowing

commendation of the Anangu people in trapping, identifying and tracking of all the reptiles in their homelands. The spinifex plays an important role in the survival of most species of reptile and certain types cohabitate.

Legless lizards don't have broad underbelly scales as snakes do and pointy noses help to distinguish them from snakes. Beaked geckos have a large range throughout Central Australia. Some listings
